





# SUBURB SPOTLIGHT



This month we head to the "Valley" Redlynch is thought to be named after a village in Wiltshire, England. Lamb Range is named after Edward William Lamb, former Queensland politician. Settlement of the area dates from the late 1870s, with land used mainly for sugar cane growing. Significant development did not occur until the 1980s. Rapid growth took place from the early 1990s, with the population increasing six-fold between 1991 and 2016 as large numbers of new dwellings were added to the area, particularly in Redlynch.

We have noticed the area being very family friendly with two great school, community sports facilities, skate park, bistro dinning and the shopping village all at your finger tips. The homes in the area comprise of block, brick and traditional Queenslander homes on large blocks especially down in the Valley area.

This suburb gives a sense of old school living where your kids can ride their bikes in the streets, participate in sporting activities and live an outdoor lifestyle.
